Meeting Goals and Agenda

Attendees: Attendees will range between 50-60 participants including corporate Roundtable members and government officials.

Theme: Advancing Employee Engagement for Sustainability

This meeting of Roundtable members will serve as a forum for sharing environmental and sustainability (E&S) best practices through presentations from experts, a networking session and a workshop to develop principles, standards and metrics for E&S education of employees. The meeting also provides an opportunity for public and private sector collaboration and sharing, including a tour of the U.S. Capitol's Green infrastructure improvements.

Goals:

- To advance best practices and trends in the field of workplace environmental sustainability education and to allow for networking of professionals in the public and private sector.
- To release and report findings from the Business and Environment's Employee Engagement Programs white paper—highlighting best practices of Green Teams, Social Media, Volunteerism and Awards and Incentives programs.
- To begin development of a set of principles, standards and indicators to measure the impact of E&S education.
- To discuss the future role of NEEF's Business and Environment Program and the Roundtable.
