



National Public Lands Day 2026 Fee-free Coupon Guidelines

Ordering Coupons

1. Fee-free coupons are ordered through the National Public Lands Day (NPLD) event registration process at www.neefusa.org/NPLD
2. Fee-free coupons must be mailed to a physical address. If the address is unreliable for USPS delivery, the site manager should choose another shipping address. Some addresses do not appear in USPS lookups, and we have recommended a home address as an alternative to ensure delivery.
3. Site managers who request Fee-free coupons will receive a confirmation email. **If a confirmation email is not received, then the order did not go through.**

Accepting Coupons

1. Fee-free coupons are valid for entrance fees and day use fees at participating federal public land sites. If a federal agency's logo appears on the Fee-free coupon, the coupon is valid at that agency's sites.
2. Fee-free coupons are valid for entrance fees or day use fees do not cover use fees or permits, such as parking, camping, tours, or concession-operated facilities.
3. Fee-free coupons are nontransferable and must have the participant's name on them before they leave an NPLD event. Blank coupons are invalid.
4. Fee-free coupons admit the person named on the coupon and any accompanying passengers in a private, noncommercial vehicle used for recreation purposes.
5. In areas where a per-person fee is charged, the coupon admits the person whose name appears on the front and three persons (16 years and older).
6. Site managers are responsible for shredding unused coupons after NPLD.
7. Participating federal land agencies are not responsible for misplaced, lost, or stolen coupons.
8. NPLD 2026 coupons expire on September 25, 2027.
9. Decisions on distributing and accepting Fee-free coupons are up to the public lands site or agency leadership, not NEEF. Any questions should be directed to the relevant site or agency leadership accordingly.
