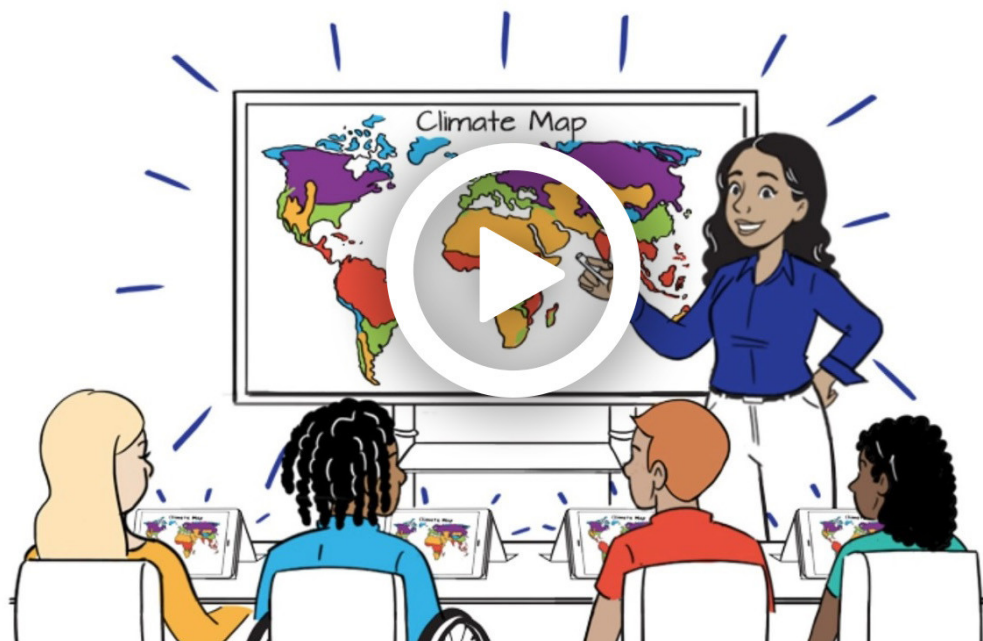


Win prizes for teaching your students about the environment?
